YOUTH CAMP DRESS CODE - OUR GUIDELINE IS MODESTY

All campers must dress in modest clothing. No shorts, cut-offs, low-cut or tank tops are permitted at Camp except as follows. Clothing considered appropriate for Sunday evening and/or mid-week worship Service/Youth Service should be worn to youth camp Evening Worship Services. We honor God by how we present ourselves during a worship service.

WHAT CLOTHES SHOULD MY CAMPER BRING"

Camp activities are best performed in play clothes that can handle wear and tear. Shorts, tees, and sneakers are suitable for day activities. Comfort is important so please remember that July is typically hot and humid. WHAT ARTICLES OF CLOTHING ARE NOT APPROPRIATE FOR CAMP? We ask parents to help us adhere to a Christian standard of modesty by not allowing campers to pack the following: No clothing that promotes gangs, violence, weapons, drugs or alcohol. Shorts/skirt length should be knee length. Clothing should not reveal undergarments, cleavage, or the midriff. The following items are not allowed: oversized armhole sleeves; see-through garments; formfitting shorts; cut-offs, torn or ripped clothing; extremely oversized clothing; spaghetti strap shirts, camis (without appropriate clothing articles overtop) or tube tops.
