#### Camp Management

- List of projects needing done for this year.
  - \*Replace toilets in upstairs ministers building
  - \*Roof on cabin #2
  - \*Exterior emergency exit door upstairs in Ministers building needs to be fixed
  - \*Back doors on 6 row need attention
  - \*Check all railings/porches for safety and make repairs if needed
  - \*The rest of Wooden porches, ramps, railing, and outside wood needs stained and sealed. (David Bish?)
  - \*Girls dorm releveled & blocked
  - \*All 5 Storm doors on the dining Hall need attention
  - \*New roof on the van garage
  - \*New roof on Electric house
  - \*Boys dorm needs to be rewired
  - \*Lots of trees need professionally trimmed (and a few need to come down)
  - \*Skirting around the 6 row needs to be completed

## Other Topics

- Numerous and very generous donations have been received in memoriam of Janet Lovich.
   Discussions will occur at a later date to determine how to best use the monies that would honor
   Janet. We would like to express our Gratitude to the Lovich Family for all their donations!
- A Letter was received from the Executive Committee of the Ministerial Council of the Church of God stating intent of the Council after this year (2023) to no longer conduct Camp Crossroads at Burnside Church of God campground.

- Saturday, June 24, Bro. Ed Beck will be presenting a workshop on "Cancel Culture & Wokeism" and encouraged all to attend. Service starts at 2:30 p.m.
- Discussion ensued about the benches around the grounds being quite unsafe. Tom stated "new" benches were donated to the campgrounds from a local church that was sold. These pews will be used in the tabernacle. The dilapidated benches will be disposed of and older pews/benches in the tabernacle can then be used around the grounds.
- The new playground has been ordered and received. Installation is included in the cost. Greg and Andrea Deible prepared the area with black landscape fabric (near where the old swing set was located). Communication is ongoing with the company to secure an installation date. Once that is complete, ground cover will be necessary. After discussing the various options, it was agreed that pea gravel] would be the best option. The perimeter will be outlined with 4x6x10 treated lumber. Andrea brought up that we need to be thinking of how to winterize the playset once camp is over. Covering it will not only protect it from the elements but will deter passersby in disturbing it. Further discussion on potential solutions will occur in future meetings.
- Cook House: A much needed can opener was provided through the Betty Edmonds memorial funds. Betty had worked in the cookhouse for several years so she would be quite pleased to see the monies used in this way. Some new additions are in the works for this year's menu. Looking forward to another good year in the cookhouse. The crew in place are invaluable. A new toaster has been obtained.
- Inquiries have been made from others regarding taking over cabins or building their own cabins. An antiquated housing agreement was found. Only items 1-8 pertained to housing. The other items on the agreement pertained to "rules" and even they were rather outdated. The agreement needs to be redone/updated then taken to the Advisory Council for further recommendations/approval. Angie Lewis agreed to do work on the updates.
- Tom stated discussions will be necessary in the future in regard to shortening the number of days of camp. The length of camp will remain the same this year, however, it may be shortened for next year (possibly Sunday through Friday night).
- It was previously said that voting to accept the updated bylaws would occur at this Spring
  meeting. However, Bro. Glenn's email expressed concerns with removing the old bylaws and
  replacing them with new ones. His expectation is that they be amended not annulled. Addison
  Hockins stated he agreed completely and explained that it is not the intent to completely
  overhaul the bylaws. He explained the wording has simply been updated and the arrangement
  has been reorganized according to Robert's Rules of Order. Evelyn's friend, who is well versed in
  the proper ways of writing bylaws, made further corrections. It was discussed that Addison
  Hockins complete the updates and compile everything so that it can then be presented to the
  Advisory Council and Board of Directors for consideration and input.


