Camp Management

- Jerry Crowe presented a list of projects completed and an extensive list of projects needing to be done
- Jerry plans to come on 6/22 and 6/29 to prepare the grounds for Youth Camp (which starts 6/30). No other work days are scheduled at this time due to lack of participation.
- Contact Jerry if you are interested in volunteering or plan to come and work on own.
- Mowing had been done by a local company this past year. Monies were donated by Sister Ann Webb-Morris to pay for 8 mowings. There are still monies in the reserved fund for one more mowing. Dave suggested having the company mow at least four more times before family camp starts. Jerry made a motion for the company to mow three more times at a cost of \$200 each time. Second by Stanley. Dave will contact the company and ask that they mow during the weeks of May 6, May 27, June 10, and July 22 (noting that family camp starts on July 26). Sister Regina stated they will also mow the week prior to Crossroads Youth Camp.
- **Jerry mentioned that if anyone has any extra tools that could be donated to the campgrounds and could be left there would be very helpful in making sure tools are on hand when needed.**

Board of Directors

- Three board members' terms expire this year: Jerry Crowe, Andrea Deible, and Addison Hockins. All have agreed to keep their names on the ballot. Voting will take place at the Fall General Business Meeting. August 1, 2024

Other Topics

- Jerry reports the controls on the hot bar have been received and will be replaced prior to the start of Camp Crossroads.
- **Jerry stated the small electric skillets that are used during workday are becoming rusty. If anyone has any to donate, it would be greatly appreciated.**

- Angie stated she has a washer and dryer to donate for the grounds. It was suggested that the stone house would probably be the best location for them, Jerry will look into the issue of getting them the adequate power. It was suggested the room be locked during service times. Dave also mentioned the possibility of setting them up to be coin operated.
- Angie said she is in need of 5 vacuum cleaners (approximately \$50/each) and 2 outside storage closets (approximately \$150) for the campgrounds. Jerry made a motion to buy these items at a cost not to exceed \$500.
