Camp Management

- For Summer of 2020 the only camp maintenance done was the mowing and trimming of the grounds, no water or electric was turned on.
- For Summer of 2021 lots more mowing and trimming was done along with turning water into all the buildings and making many needed repairs.
- Before Camp Meeting 2021 lots of Maintenance projects were completed along with repairs. The Nursery porch was leveled and secured, along with new lights installed inside. Kitchen shelves were reinforced, Dining Hall roof was caulked, and a new double filtered sink was installed for drinking water.
- There is still a long list of things that still need to be done
 - Trees trimmed off the buildings
 - The screen doors on the back of the 6 row building need work
 - Exterior Doors in the Ministers building need repaired
 - All the wooden porches, ramps, railing, and outside wood need stained and sealed.
 - 6 more Tabernacle Fans need replaced with exterior fans (2 fans were donated and installed by Tim & Lindy Russell)
 - Tabernacle needs a NEW ROOF
 - Tabernacle left side window hinges need switched so the windows open upwards or shade screens installed.
- Stanley Jones was added to the Maintenance committee as a Maintenance Assistant.
