### CELL PHONE USAGE

Youth Camp provides a balanced program of both physical and spiritual activities designed to foster the growth of a well-rounded Christian character. Campers will engage in worship, fellowship, study, sports, work, and play, all in a setting that encourages cooperation and personal development. Experienced staff members will closely supervise all activities to help ensure each child's safety. Please note, however, that the camp cannot accept responsibility for any accidents that may occur.

### **Camp Fee: \$200.00 Each Week \$75.00 For Children Of Camp Staff**

Camp is for those ages 9 - 18. Eight-year-olds may attend if their parent serves on the Camp staff. The Application Form and a registration fee of \$10 must be received at the address below not later than May 15th. The \$190 balance of the fee is due at camp. For families who send more than one child the total fee is \$190.00 for the second child, \$180.00 for the third, \$170.00 for the fourth and so on. **Applications received after May 15th must be accompanied by a \$20 late fee.** Registration will be completely closed on June 12<sup>th</sup>; any exceptions must be discussed with the director prior to the start of camp. **The Application Form must be signed by the camper's parent and pastor!** Please make checks payable to: **Ministerial Council Of The Church Of God**

### **Dress Code Policy**

#### **Our Guideline is Modesty**

All campers are required to wear modest clothing while at camp. Items such as short shorts, short skirts, cut-offs, low-cut tops, and tank tops are not permitted. For evening worship services, campers should dress in clothing suitable for Sunday or mid-week worship services, which means no shorts are allowed. We believe that honoring God includes how we present ourselves during worship.

### **Appropriate Attire for Camp Activities**

#### **What Clothes Should My Camper Bring?**

Camp activities are best enjoyed in comfortable play clothes that can withstand active use. Recommended items include shorts, t-shirts, and sneakers for daytime activities. Since June and July are typically hot and humid, comfort should be a priority when selecting clothing.

### **Inappropriate Clothing and Items**

#### **What Articles of Clothing Are Not Appropriate for Camp?**

To maintain a Christian standard of modesty, parents are asked not to send campers with clothing that promotes gangs, violence, weapons, drugs, or alcohol. Shorts and skirts must be at least knee length. Clothing should not reveal undergarments, cleavage, or midriff. The following items are not allowed: oversized armhole sleeves, see-through garments, form-fitting shorts, cut-offs, torn or ripped clothing, extremely oversized clothing, spaghetti strap shirts, camis (unless covered appropriately), or tube tops.

**Campers may not wear jewelry.**

### **Camp Conduct and Discipline**

#### **Full Cooperation and Discipline of All Campers Is Expected!**

Any camper whose conduct is considered unbecoming by the Ministerial Council may be dismissed from camp without refund of the camp fee.

### **Visitor and Communication Guidelines**

To minimize distractions, youth camp is restricted to staff and registered campers only. Others may access the grounds only with permission from the director. Please contact the camp director or your pastor if you wish to arrange a visit during camp.

**Parents and campers are requested to restrict telephone calls to emergency situations only.**

### **Departure Policy**

**Campers are to leave youth camp no later than 9:00 A.M. Friday morning.**
